

We're 5 days in to 2018 and hopefully all those who made resolutions are still going strong! Did you know what the number one Resolution was this year? No, it wasn't to take down Christmas lights before July (although that is a good one!) - rather this year the number 1 Resolution was "To Become a Better Person". That resolution supplanted the most popular one from the last few years - which was losing weight. What does it actually mean to be "good?" We're talking about character, aren't we? We believe it's good to be kind, fair and just; it's bad to cheat, murder and steal. So, is character about keeping a list of do's and don'ts? If I can check off a list of good character qualities or behaviours - does that mean I'm "good?" Is it possible for my good behaviours to mask ulterior motives? Is character authentic if it's simply a mask? True character flows from motivations in our heart.

The church at Corinth are asked in a letter to consider what real character is. To SHIFT from their thinking that doing good things is the same as being a good person and instead consider how their hearts are affected by experiencing the love and grace of God daily. Grace is a supernatural work of God that *transforms* the heart and that's radically different than a work of human effort that *restrains* the heart. That's a huge and freeing difference! We're going to look at authentic character that results from a supernaturally changed heart and how each trait is cultivated in Jesus! We'll begin this Sunday in 1 Corinthians 13:1-7




HOPE Magazine!
