GETTING COMFORTABLE WITH ZOOM:

One of the reasons we use ZOOM for our Sunday Morning Gatherings is that it allows us to connect and engage almost as if we were in the same physical room! If you're unfamiliar with how ZOOM works here's some info we hope will help you use the ZOOM functions to engage together when we gather!

TO TALK DURING THE GATHERING:

If you'd like to participate by sharing in the gathering during the prayer time or in dialogue by speaking then you'll need to use the "Raise Hand" and "Unmute" features. Those steps depend on what device you're using and images my differ:

IF YOU'RE USING A DESKTOP COMPUTER:

> At the bottom of the window, click the button labeled "RAISE HAND"



- > Your "digital hand" is now raised to let us know you'd like to share.
- > The host will let you know when it's your turn to share then you'll need to UNMUTE your microphone. To do that you can click the button at the bottom left of your screen when it says UNMUTE and then you can begin sharing



> When you're finished sharing - you can MUTE your microphone again



> Don't forget to click the button that says "LOWER HAND" ... otherwise your digital hand will get tired!



TO CHAT WITH THE HOST USING A DESKTOP COMPUTER:

The CHAT feature is available to use if you'd prefer to engage that way and you access that by clicking the CHAT icon and typing in the chat window on the right hand side of your screen.

TO CHAT WITH THE HOST USING A TABLET OR PHONE:

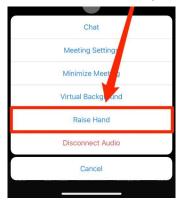
Tap the 3 horizontal dots labelled MORE and then tap CHAT on the pop up menu

IF YOU'RE USING A TABLET OR A PHONE:

> In the bottom right corner of your screen - tap on the 3 horizontal dots labelled MORE



> In the pop up menu - tap "RAISE HAND" and that will raise your "digital hand" to let us know you'd like to share.



> The host will let you know when it's your turn to share - then you'll need to UNMUTE your microphone and you do that by clicking the UNMUTE icon in the lower left corner



> After sharing - tap the 3 horizontal dots labelled MORE and then tap the words LOWER HAND ... or your digital hand will get tired!



> You can then MUTE your microphone by taping the MUTE icon in the lower left corner





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
