We know that this has been a challenging season for all students as they and their teachers have transitioned to distance learning. Some students are making big changes in the fall - many are moving from primary to middle or from middle to high school or high school to college or university or to seeking employment are taking a big step and even with the amazing efforts of teachers and schools - the circumstances are just not the same as they were anticipating to help them close one chapter and begin another adventure. So what we'd like to do is stand with them as a one bug family and take some time next Sunday - June 28, to speak words of blessing into their lives. Words that will ADD STRENGTH to them.

So here's what we'd like to ask you to do and everyone can play a part!

Mom's and Dad's: If your daughter or son is in grade 5 going into grade 6 or grade 8 going into grade 9 next year or beginning a job or going to College or University in the fall or Graduating from College or University can you send us their picture? And if you've have some kind of grad picture - awesome. Send it to **Dean** 

**Secondly the entire Nashville Road family:** We want to hear your words of encouragement and wisdom. So we've put a little guide in the eNews and on the website that will help you think about and share some thoughts and blessings it can be something you've learned on your Journey - some advice someone gave you when you graduated or it can be a a favourite verse or something God showed you as you stepped into a new adventure from one school to another or to a new stage in your life.

Then you can submit those thoughts in one of 2 ways - You can either go to the <u>NRCC Soundstage starting Monday</u> <u>June 22nd</u> and record an audio message/blessing or you can submit your message/blessing on a video and email it to <u>Dean.</u> You decide!

It has been encouraging to hear the announcement this week from our Provincial government, to allow the re-opening of places of worship! While we look forward to returning to gathering under the same physical roof as soon as possible - we want to engage a safe and phased return with the same emphasis on care and concern for our community that we practiced when we halted our physical gatherings at the beginning of the COVID-19 crisis.

Each church body has their own unique situations and Nashville Road's uniqueness includes serving our community through both a school and a Day Care Center. So our planning to return to gathering together, must include a wise approach that reflects our commitment to the health and safety of all who enter our building.

For the time being we will continue to gather online under a digital roof, even as we develop our return plan – taking into consideration our own specific needs as a body <u>and</u> making sure all the Provincial, Municipal and various community needs are fully met. At this point our timeline for returning to meet in person will be based on when we can do so safely and allow the full body of NRCC to gather together.

As we ask for your patience we also will ask for your input and engagement to make sure we understand your feelings and expectations regarding a wise return to meeting again in person. As we continue planning for the reopening of the Nashville Road building we want to hear from the NRCC body. We have a very short but important survey that will give us all the chance to share how we're feeling as we continue to prepare for a return to in-person gatherings.

NASHVILLE ROAD RETURN TO IN-PERSON GATHERINGS SURVEY

While we work on that plan we will be intentional regarding:

**DIRECTION:** We will communicate consistently and provide guided leadership as we formulate plans and prepare to reopen.

**PROTECTION:** We will provide sound governance, management and implement wise procedures in consultation with our Regional Health Care professionals to ensure the continued health and safety for our community upon that return.

**REFLECTION:** We know that God has been working in and through all of us over this challenging season. So we are asking each of us to reflect on what God is inviting us to now and challenging us to consider as we return to a gathered church body.

We very much look forward to returning to gathered celebrations as the Nashville Road body! As we live out the love of God - we continue to pray for our community: for those who are sick, for those who have lost loved ones and for all those front-line workers who are serving so faithfully.



## **TOGETHER!**

Nashville Road is a people who! Our desire has been to practice bring family and ensure no one feels isolated or alone even as we wisely practice physical distancing. As we work towards a return to in-person gatherings under the same physical roof - we'll continue to gather under a *digital roof* thru our phones, computers and TV's!

Sunday mornings at 10:30 we continue to join together online to worship God! Our gathering "place" is our NRCC TOGETHER space! It gives us the opportunity to engage together from our own living rooms around our city and connect, sing, pray, chat and encourage one another to live out God's love as good neighbours in our communities.

You can check out the interface anytime. If you're new to that - there's no need to sign up or login to be part of the gathering and there's some basic "how-to" info on the next page in order to take advantage of our online time together. We go live on Sunday morning at 10:30. So stay in your PJ's if you want, grab some coffee, gather your fam, and click the button below and be NRCC Together!

There are other ways to stay connected as the NRCC family throughout the week - like Instagram and Facebook. If you're not already connected on those social media platforms - <u>just click here</u> to head over to our website where those links are posted to help you connect.

And if you missed gathering live at 10:30 - we'll also post the video from that gathering there immediately afterwards.



## **SUNDAY ONLINE INFO:**

Just like the "lobby" of the physical church building is open prior to our physical gatherings for people to chat and engage - when you gather under our digital roof on Sunday mornings - the chat function is available at 10:15am for those who arrive a little earlier and remains open for roughly 30 minutes after the Sunday video feed is finished. Also if you arrive anytime before 10:30 on a Sunday morning - a standard looping video that plays throughout the week is onscreen. Our Sunday video feed should begin automatically at 10:30 with a 1 minute countdown so you don't need to press play. If the video doesn't begin automatically then clicking the REFRESH button should fix any lag. If you're unable to begin the gathering at 10:30 and arrive later - think about it like you're coming into the gym from the lobby at 10:40 and joining the gathering live. To do that - just hit REFRESH and you can join the gathering in progress - which allows you to be in sync with wherever the gathering is at that point in time. Whereas if you press play and "start" the gathering from the beginning manually at another time, say at 10:40 - then you'll be 10 minutes behind and slightly out of sync - which you may notice affects the timing of your comments in the chat window. Oh and please remember to also click the **UNMUTE** button on the main view screen to have sound!

## **SUPPORTING OUR LOCAL BUSINESSES!**


