

Summer Reading - <u>Jesus & The Eyewitnesses</u> by Richard Bauckham

'Jesus and the Eyewitness' argues that the four Gospels are closely based on the eyewitness testimony of those who knew Jesus. Richard Bauckham taps into the rich resources of modern cognitive psychology and calls readers to end the classic division between the 'historical Jesus' and the'Christ of faith', proposing instead the 'Jesus of testimony' as presented by the Gospels. A little heavier summer reading but very helpful for all who seek to understand the origins of the Gospels and build on a solid foundation for life. Another companion to our "I Am" series as it helps answer the question - Who do you say that Jesus is.

On the job front, I had 2 interviews last week, and then I have another 2 interviews this coming week. Because the hiring process is extensive I was told it could be a few weeks before I know the outcome of the interviews. I will be meeting with the Austrings this weekend, as hey are doing mission with First Nations through NAIM not far from Nanaimo.
