


LIVING OUT THE LOVE OF GOD LOCALLY AND GLOBALLY

Both these are great ways to live out/express God's love as a body. There are boxes set out in the lobby for your contributions! Thanks for living out loud!




NURSERY MINISTRY TEAMSUNDAY MORNINGS / 10:30AM

We're also looking for an interim Nursery Director to help co-ordinate and encourage our Nursery Volunteers.


