Regeneration Outreach Community has a great opportunity for students to engage with guests at Regen and learn about the ways that the Christian faith calls for action.

HOMEBOUND will immerse students in the rhythms and activities of guests at Regen as each morning students will participate and lead in various programs with guests and build relationships. Afternoon programming will include guest speakers, bible studies and engaging workshops that will challenge students to examine their faith as it intersects with the life of Jesus and issues of poverty. They will have the chance to study Yahweh's heart for the marginalized, Jesus' ministry to the poor and the church's opportunity and responsibility to bring God's Kingdom near - developing a lifestyle of expressing faith thru love.

The cost is \$100 per person and includes breakfast, lunch, transportation for the program's activities. Enrollment is limited to 12 students in total.
