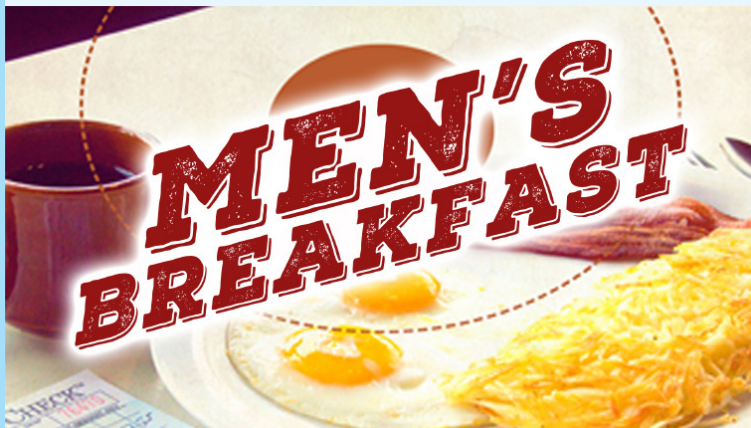
MOVING WITH MUSIC
